To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to Subsection 262.6(b) of the Copyright Office's regulations, 37 C.F.R. § 262.6(b), SoundExchange hereby notifies the Copyright Office of its intent to audit DMX Music, Inc ("DMX") for transmissions made by DMX pursuant to the exemption set forth in 17 U.S.C. § 114(d)(1)(C)(iv) for "Business Establishment Service" transmissions.

SoundExchange, the sole collective designated by the Copyright Office to collect and distribute the statutory royalties paid by Business Establishment Services under 37 C.F.R. § 262.4(b), is specifically authorized to audit DMX as the Designated Agent of copyright owners and performers.
