



The total recordable case (TRC) rate was highest (5.5 per 100 full-time workers) among mid-sized establishments with 50 to 249 employees. Larger and smaller establishments had lower rates than these mid-sized establishments.

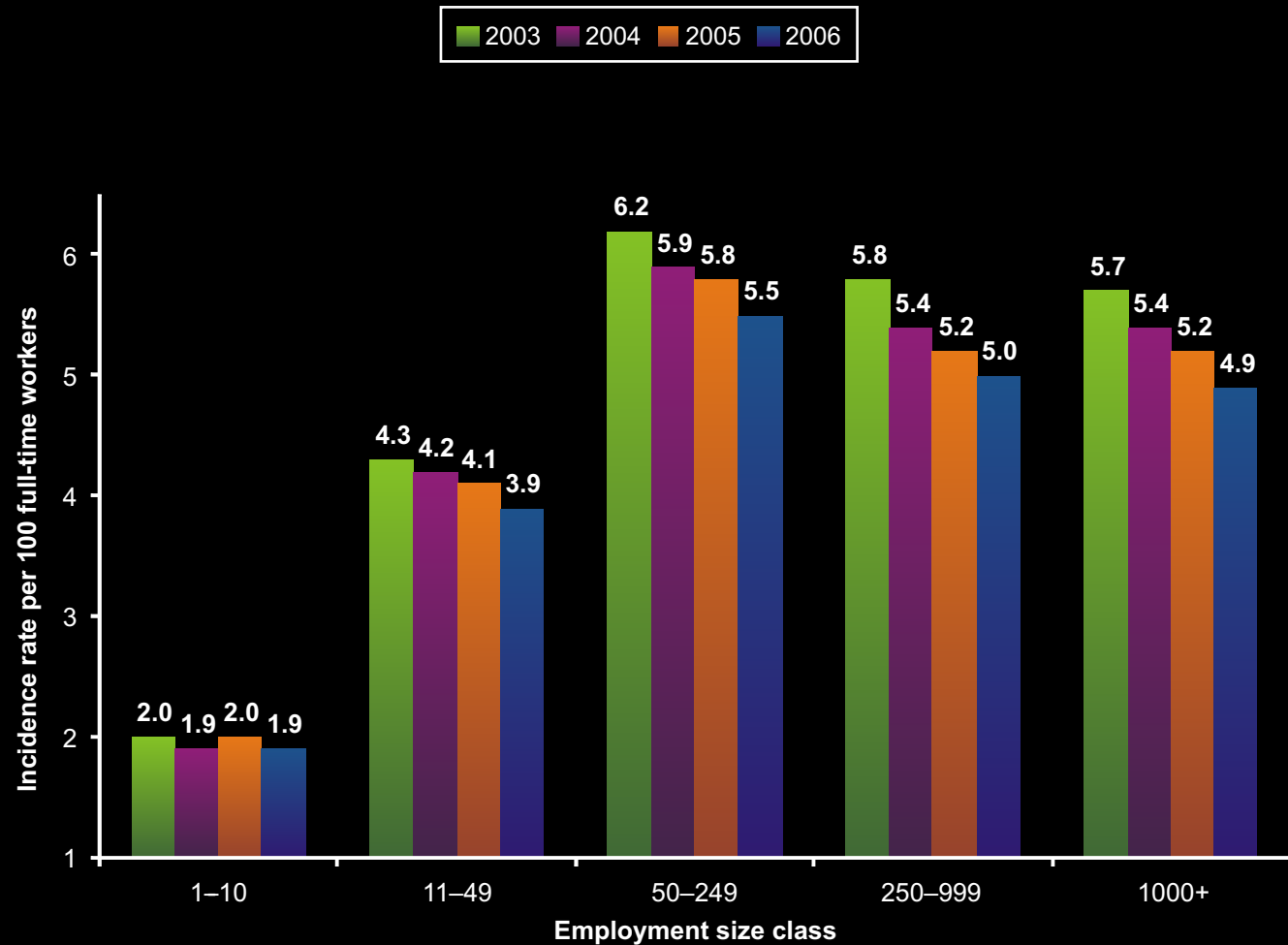
Small establishments—those with 1 to 10 employees—had the lowest TRC rate (1.9). The rate for these establishments remained relatively unchanged from 2005 to 2006.

TRC rates declined for all other size classes during the same period.
