Dear Mr. Secretary:

We would like to comment on the forthcoming decisions to be made on the guidelines for "Made in USA" labels. In our opinion we would encourage the FTC to establish two categories:

- 1. MADE IN THE USA: This label would be used for those products of which at least 98% of the manufacturing costs are incurred in the United States.
- 2. ASSEMBLED IN THE USA: This label may be used by a manufacturer who does not qualify for the "MADE IN THE USA" label. When used however, the label must disclose the percentage of the assembly process which occurred in the US.

We feel strongly that the interests of the United States are at stake here and would like to see these recommendations implemented. Thank you for consideration.
