
Subject: The Department of the Navy (DoN) Approach to Unique Identification (UID) Initial Operating Capability (IOC) for Parts Marking at DoN Depots and Shipyards

Enclosure (1) is a draft plan for Unique Identification (UID) IOC and will be updated as appropriate upon the availability of information. Significant infrastructure requirements, critical path issues, risks and challenges are currently under review for accurate details. Enclosure (2) lists notional dates and durations currently under validation.

We will continue to refine these plans and present Depots and Shipyards Full Operating Capability (FOC) plans for our remaining depots. Full funding and completion of previously identified depot implementation cost study and pilot projects ensure accurate, rigorous and executable FOC Plans, Budget Estimates and Program Objective Memorandums (POM) submittals for our Depots and Shipyards.
