Validation of the Content

Formats:

- Symbol Quality
 - ISO 15415 labels
 - AIM DPM Guide (ISO Standard in the works)
 - AS 9132

Mark Quality

- Mark Content
 - No Syntax
 - Invalid Data Set
 - Mark with NO encoded data
- Symbol Quality
 - Hard to Read
 - Surface Issues
 - Symbol Orientation
 - Poor Quality
 - Inappropriate Method for Application
 - Bad Symbol

Bottom Line: FACT or FICTION? and Way Ahead

Registration Process

- Original Equipment Manufacturers
 - Contract Requirement
 - Registration NOT Accomplished Prior to Acceptance
 - GFE and GFM Not Marked or Registered
- Legacy Marking
 - Hampered by "Lack of" or "Unwilling" Design Authority (marking method issue)
 - Data Submission Difficulties
 - Lack of System Interface Agreement/Capability
 - Legacy Systems Issues
 - Data standards used
 - Field Lengths/Types
 - Data Submission Instructions/Methods Not Sufficient

Bottom Line: FACT or FICTION? and Way Ahead

IUID Data Quality

- Data in Existing Systems
 - Dirty Data
 - Doesn't Fulfill IUID Requirements
- Data Submitted
 - Incomplete
 - Inaccurate
 - Inappropriate Usage (e.g. used innate serialization on legacy)
