

PICACHO PEAK WILDERNESS
8,805 Acres
Designated October 31, 1994 by the California Desert Protection Act,
Public Law 103-433

This is the final legal description as required in Section 103(b) of the above mentioned Act. It describes the boundary for the Picacho Peak Wilderness area located in Imperial County, California and managed by the Bureau of Land Management. The boundary is more particularly described as follows:

From the corner of sections 20, 21, 28 and 29, T. 13 S., R. 22 E., S.B.M., and identical with the intersection of the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary, this point being the point of beginning;

thence southwesterly leaving the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary, to point 1, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet westerly of the centerline of a jeep trail and a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of the centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates of 33°00'44" N. latitude, 114°41'10" W. longitude, as scaled from the U.S.G.S. 7 ½ minute Quadrangle "Picacho SW, Calif.-Ariz.", 1965;

thence southwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northerly of said centerline to point 2, a point 30 feet West of a junction of washes, said junction having NAD 1927 coordinates of 32°58'28" N. latitude, 114°44'09" W. longitude, as scaled from the U.S.G.S. 7 ½ minute Quadrangle "Picacho Peak, Calif.", 1965;

thence west to point 3, a point 30 feet easterly of the centerline of a jeep trail;

thence northwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet easterly of said centerline to point 4, the intersection with the section line between protracted sections 27 and 34, T. 13 S., R. 21 E.;

thence westerly between protracted sections 27 and 34, 28 and 33, and 29 and 32 to point 5, the intersection of a line parallel with and 100 feet easterly of the centerline of Indian Pass Road;

thence northeasterly, parallel with and 100 feet easterly of said centerline to point 6, the intersection of the section line between sections 17 and 18, T. 13 S., R. 22 E., said point identical with the intersection of the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary ;

thence southerly between sections 17 and 18 along the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary, to point 7, the corner of sections 17, 18, 19, and 20;

thence easterly between sections 17 and 20 along the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary, to point 8, the corner of sections 16, 17, 20, and 21;

thence southerly between sections 20 and 21 along the Picacho State Recreation Area boundary, to the point of beginning.



The boundary calls listed herein are in part a result of scaling distances from said quad maps and are not a result of survey. All courses have been depicted upon the above mentioned quad maps and are made a part of this official record. Acreage is calculated from the California State Office ArcInfo wilderness coverage.
