In millions of workers

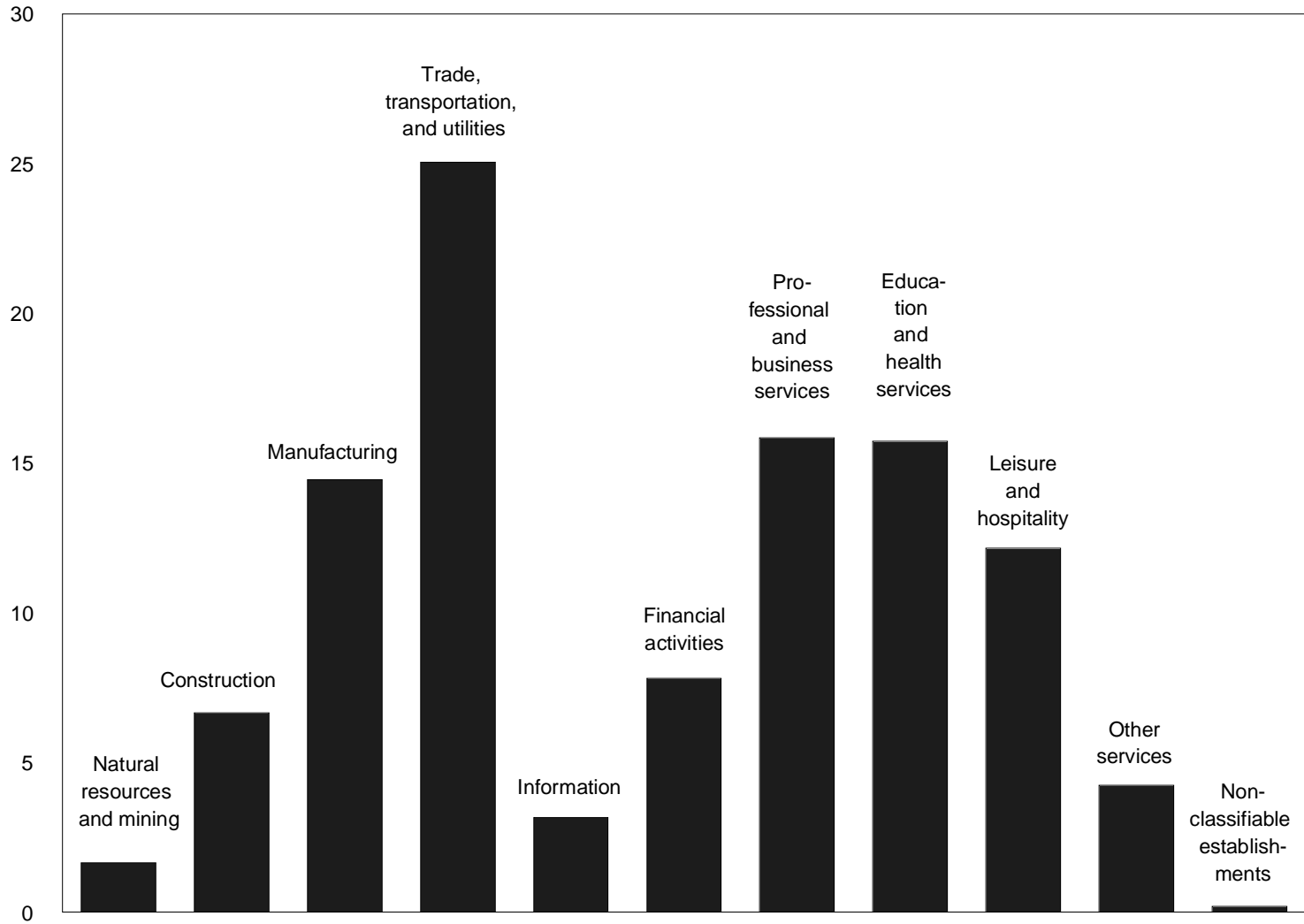


Chart 2. Percent distribution of private sector employment and establishments by size class, first quarter and March 2003

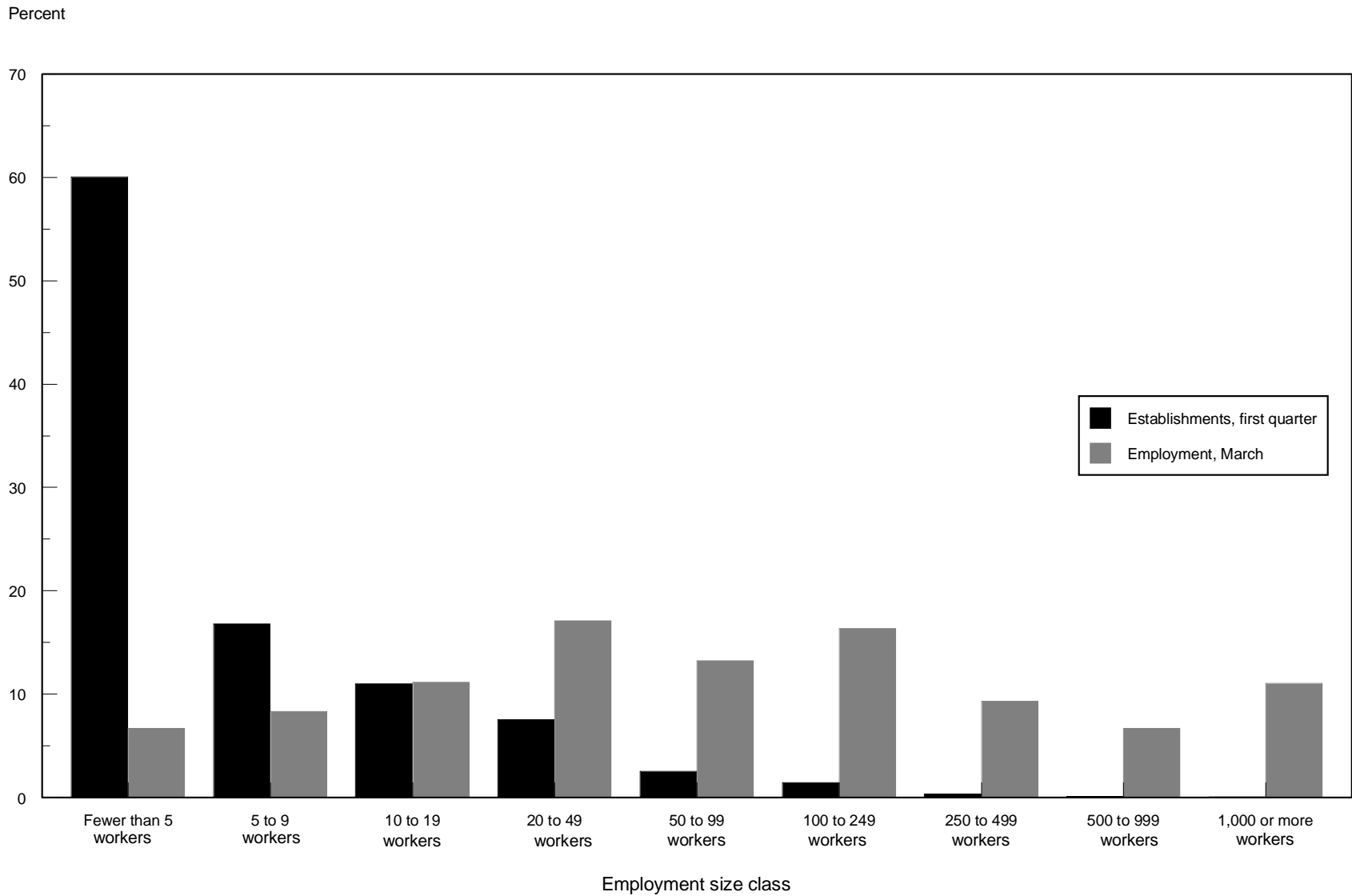


Chart 3. Percent change in annual average private sector employment and wages by supersector, 2002–2003

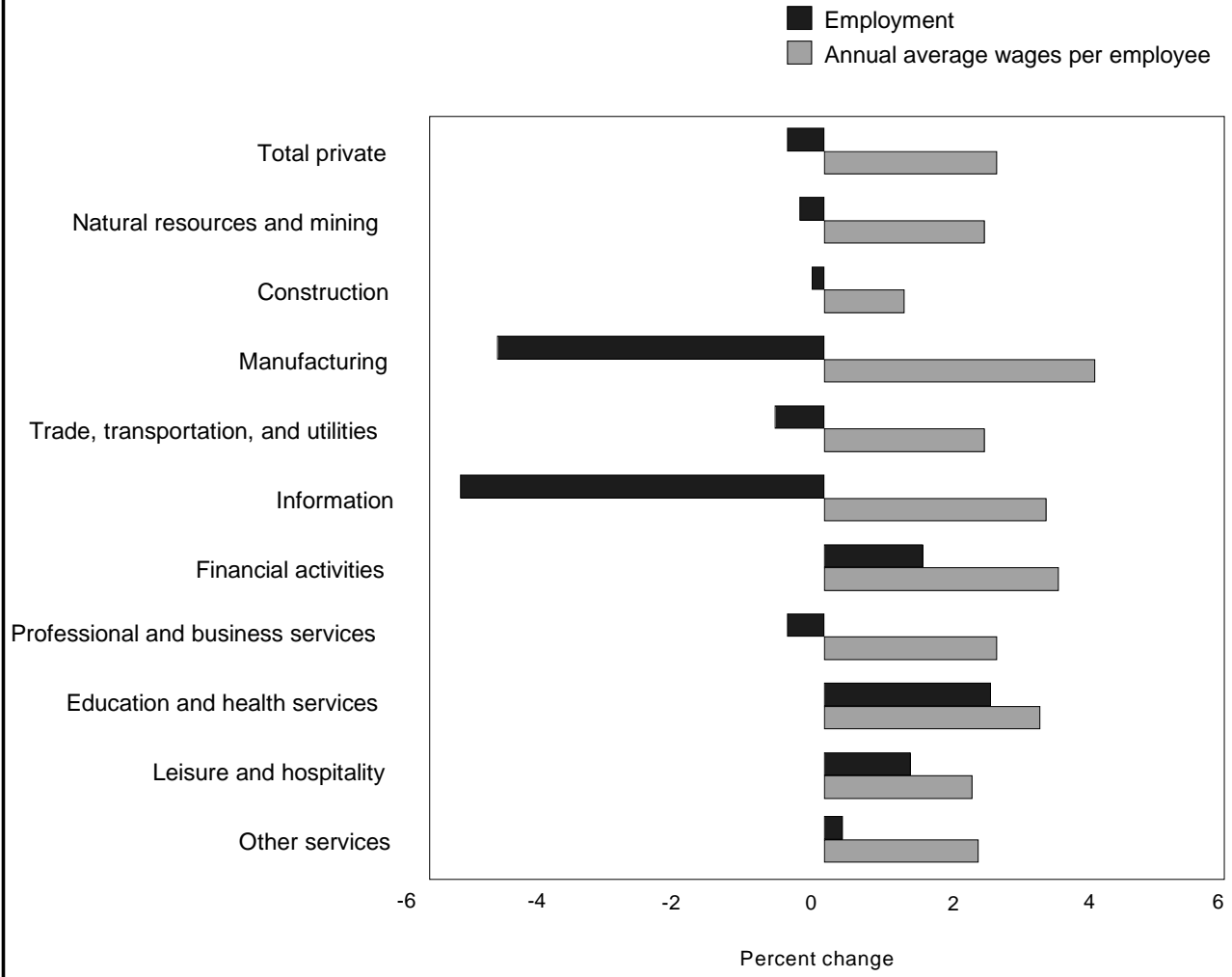
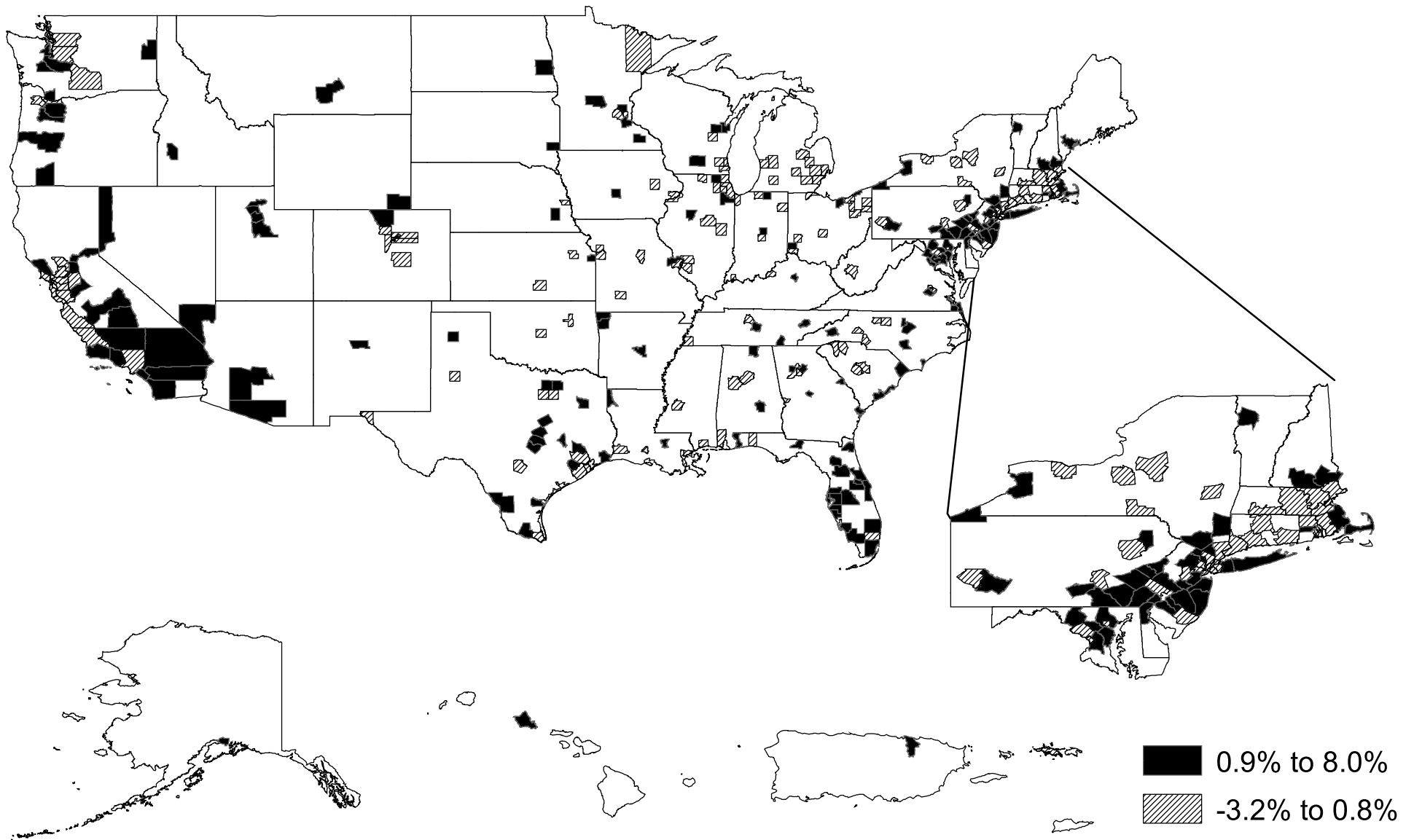
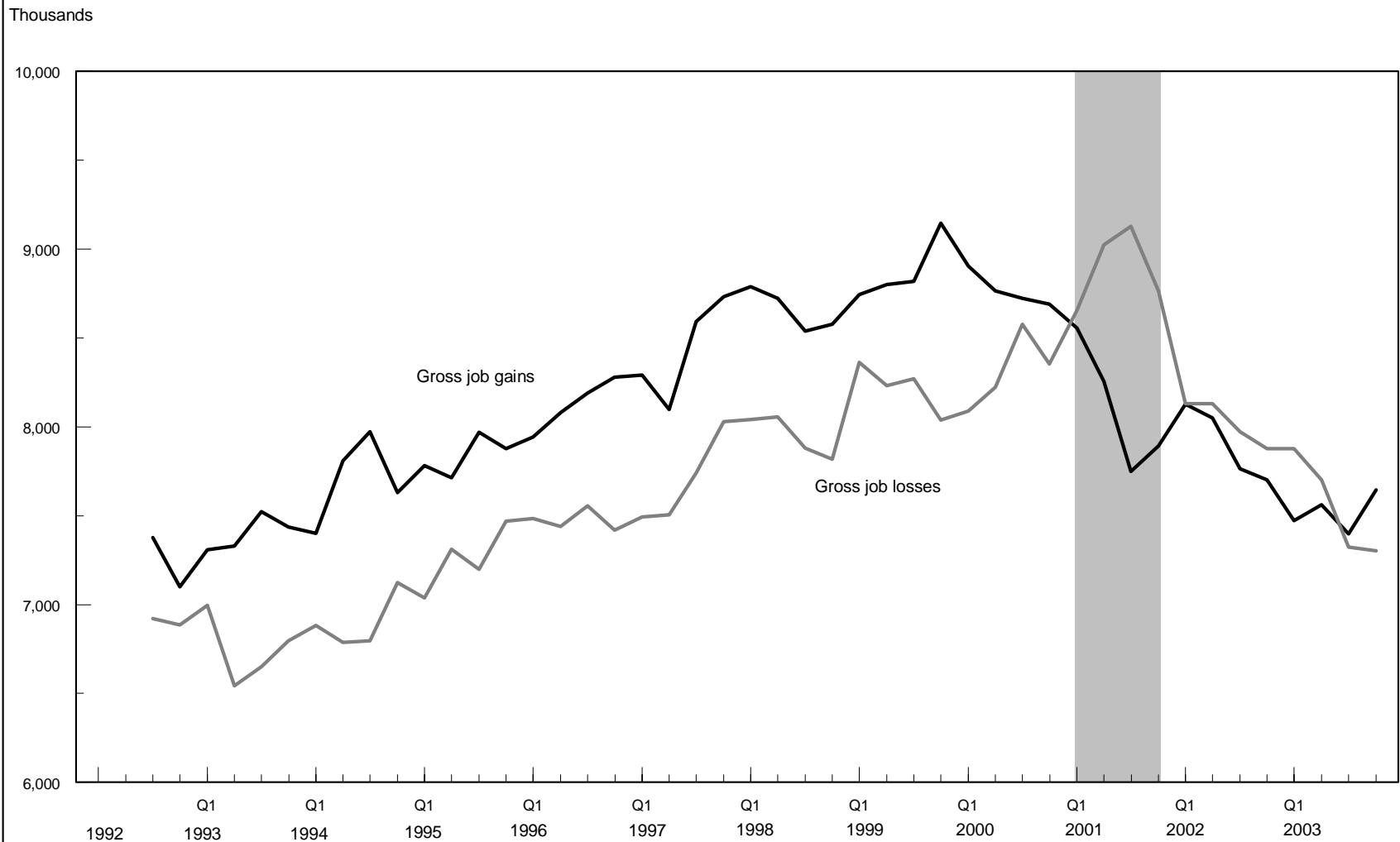


Chart 4. Percent change in employment in counties with 75,000 employees or more, March 2003–2004 (U.S. Average = 0.8%)



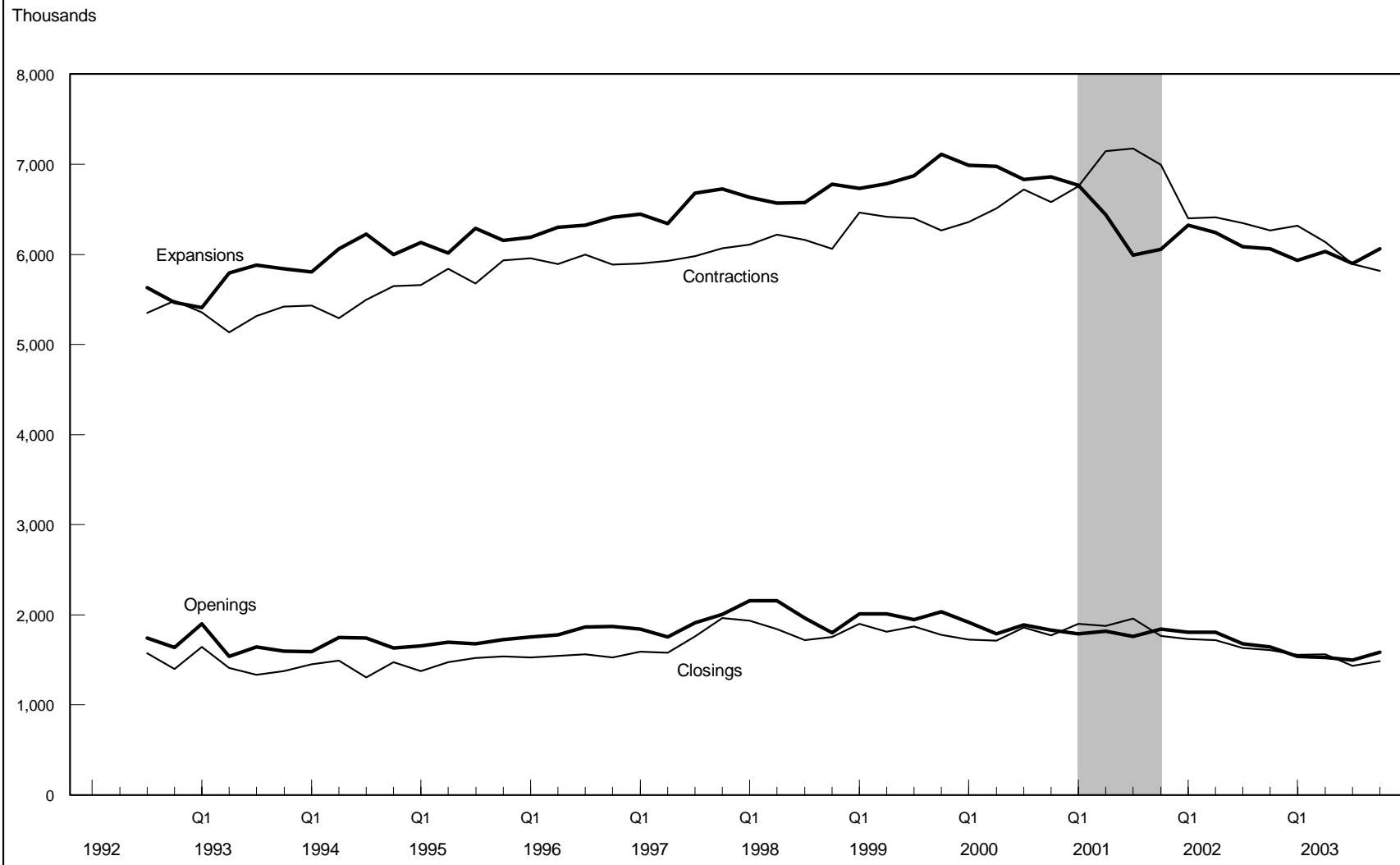
