Joseph Farrell

Joseph Farrell is Professor of Economics at the University of California, Berkeley. He is a Fellow of the Econometric Society, former Editor of the *Journal of Industrial Economics*, and former President of the Industrial Organization Society.

Professor Farrell was Chief Economist at the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in 1996-1997, and later was Deputy Assistant Attorney General for Economics at the Antitrust Division of the US Department of Justice, 2000-2001. From 2001 to 2004 he served on the Computer Science and Telecommunications Board of the National Academies of Science.
