He has advised the Japanese Ministries of International Trade and Industry and of Posts and Telecommunications, the Federal Trade Commission, and the National Association of Attorneys General on vertical restraint issues. He has served as an expert in vertical restraints matters for a number of firms, including 3M, Cessna, Bandag, Trinova, and Dentsply.
