

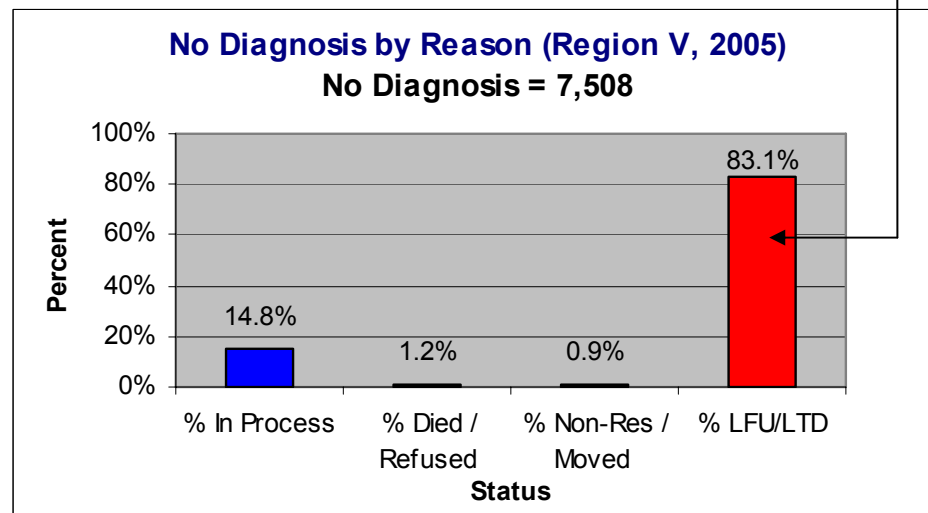
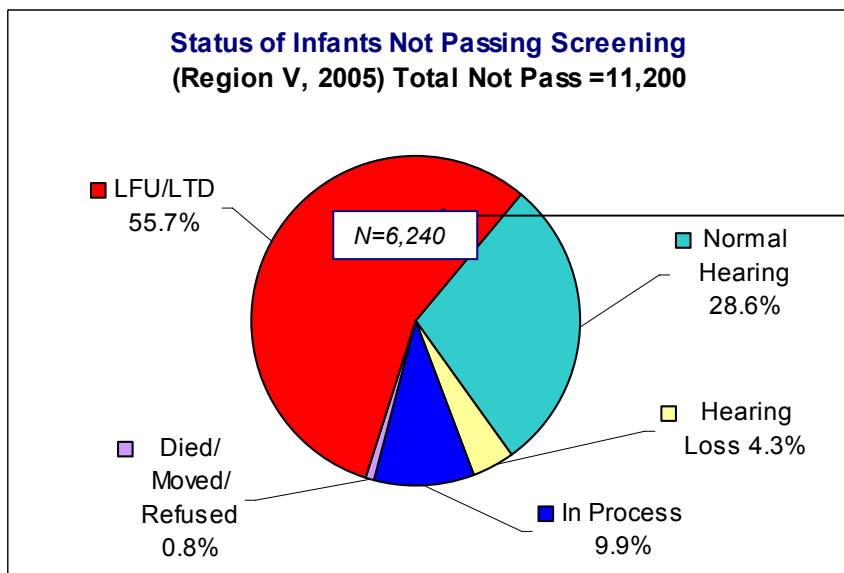
Summary of CDC-EHDI Survey Data by Region: Calendar Year 2005

- IL, IN, MI, MN, OH, WI, Puerto Rico* (**Data for Puerto Rico was not available in 2005*)

Summary of Key Data Indicators

- **Occurrent Births:** 670,649
- **Percent Not Passing (final screen):** 1.8% (11,200 infants)
- **Normal Hearing:** 3,208
- **Percent Screened:** 95.2% (638,748 infants)
- **No Diagnosis:** 7,508 (67.0%)
- **Hearing Loss / Incidence:** 484 / 0.76 per 1,000 screened



- **No Diagnosis:** Includes infants that are “In process,” “Died / Parents declined services,” “Non-residents or Moved out of jurisdiction,” and “Unable to contact / Unresponsive / Unknown”
- **LFU / LTD:** Loss to Follow-up / Loss to Documentation
 - Represents cases with no diagnosis due to reasons including “Unable to contact” or “Unresponsive” family and “Unknown” status
