

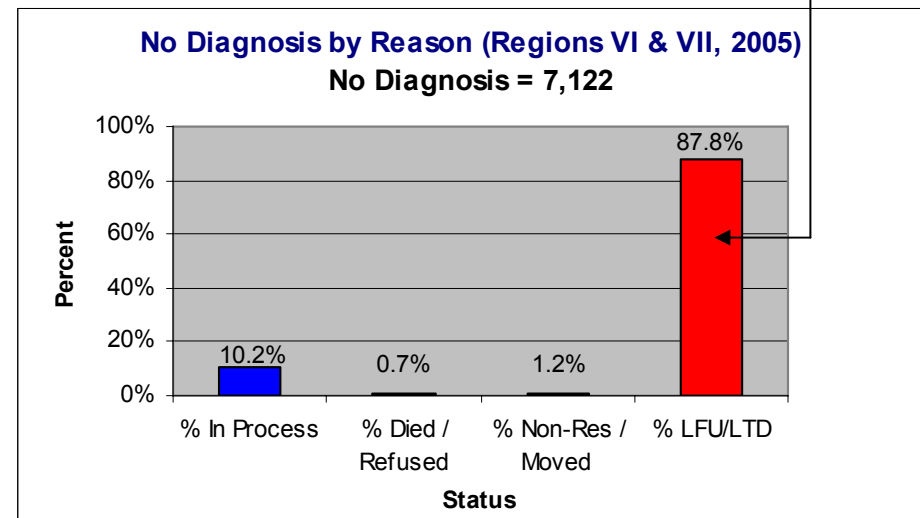
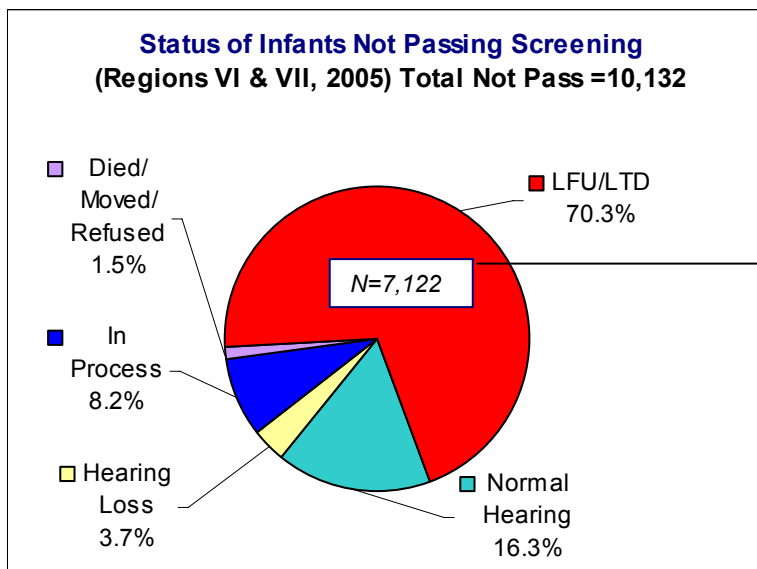
Summary of CDC-EHDI Survey Data by Region: Calendar Year 2005

Region VI and VII States

- AR, LA, NM, OK, TX, IA*, KS*, MO, NE (*Complete data for IA and KS was not available in 2005)

Summary of Key Data Indicators

- **Occurrent Births:** 643,946
- **Percent Screened:** 89.8% (578,462 infants)
- **Percent Not Passing (final screen):** 1.8% (10,132 infants)
- **Normal Hearing:** 1,647
- **No Diagnosis:** 8,112 (80.1%)
- **Normal Hearing:** 1,647
- **Hearing Loss / Incidence:** 373 / 0.64 per 1,000 screened



- **No Diagnosis:** Includes infants that are “In process,” “Died / Parents declined services,” “Non-residents or Moved out of jurisdiction,” and “Unable to contact / Unresponsive / Unknown”
- **LFU / LTD:** Loss to Follow-up / Loss to Documentation
 - Represents cases with no diagnosis due to reasons including “Unable to contact” or “Unresponsive” family and “Unknown” status
