

# Delaware, 2005

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** Delaware reported 11 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Delaware ranked 33 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 1.3 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

## Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Delaware, the rate among males was 2.2 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.5 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

## Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphilis

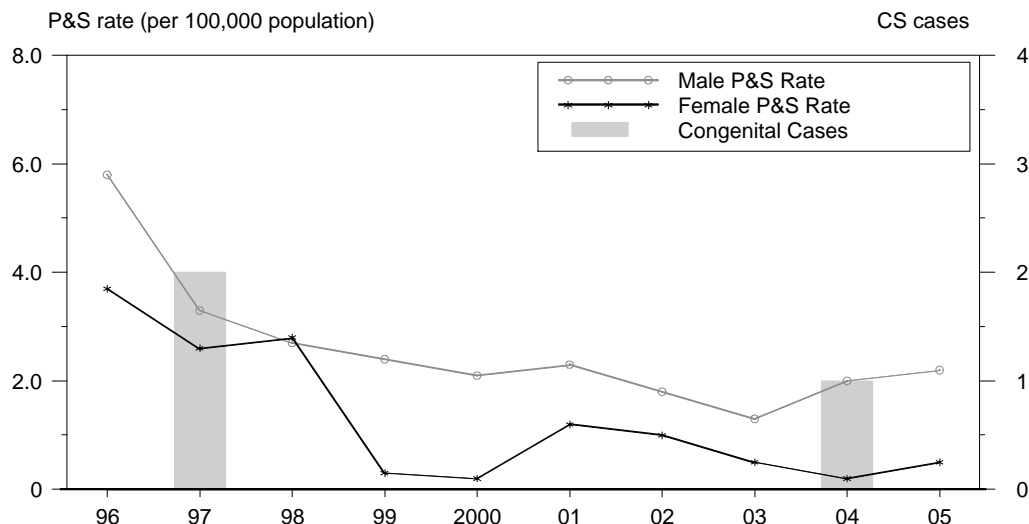
In Delaware, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.5 among whites, 3.5 among blacks, 4.2 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

- The rate among blacks was 7 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 8.4 times that of whites.

## Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** Delaware reported 0 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Delaware had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
