

2002 National EHDI Meeting

Summary

The First Annual National EHDI meeting sponsored by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB) was a great success. The meeting featured a number of presentations on current EHDI issues and also allowed a free exchange of ideas between people from several different organizations and programs.

Approximately 380 people from every state, several U.S. territories, and even Italy, Poland and other European countries attended this conference. Attendees included representatives from state EHDI programs, members of federal agencies (CDC, *HRSA/MCHB, U.S. Department of Education/*OSERS, and the *NIH/National Institute on Deafness and other Communication Disorders), EHDI Champions from state American Academy of Pediatrics chapters and several other organizations.
