Submissions should be no more than 3500 words (approx 10-12 pages), and authors should be prepared for presentations twenty minutes in length. Papers should be submitted in a Word format (.doc or .docx) with a document title the same as the paper title, and should also be prepared for a blind review. Students should include a cover sheet with their full name, paper title, institutional affiliation, mailing address, e-mail address, and phone number.

Submissions should be sent to 'untpst@gmail.com' with an accompanying abstract of 100-200 words. The electronic submission deadline is **August 1, 2011.**

Notification of acceptance will be sent out by September 17th, 2011. The conference schedule will be finalized by October 1, 2011.
