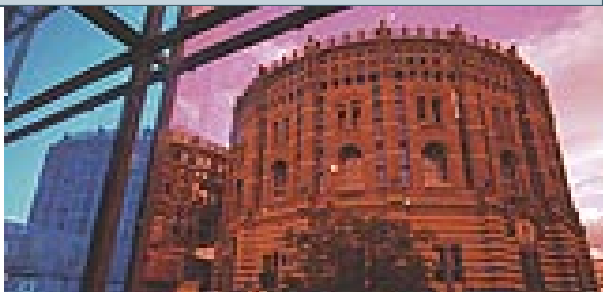

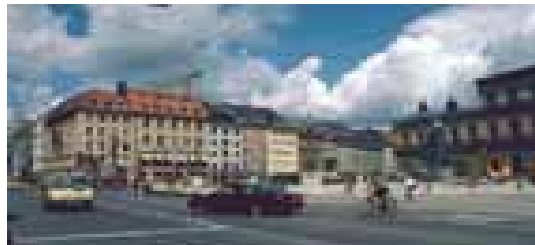

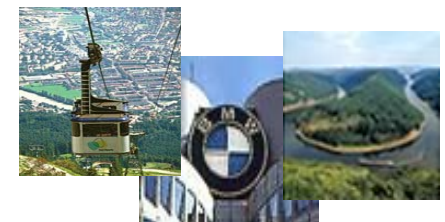

Program Schedule

The Summer-II Study Abroad Program for 2006 will be held in five locations. Sites include Vienna, Austria, Innsbruck, Austria, Slovakia, and Zurich, Switzerland

- Half-day morning guided tour of Vienna including the Schonbrunn Palace
- Full-day trip to Bratislava including entrances to St. Martin's Cathedral
- Morning walking tour of Munich
- Walking tour of Innsbruck
- Half-day trip to Swarovski Kristlwelten, a world of crystal
- Canal tour of Zurich and trip to the Rhine Falls, the biggest waterfall in Europe

The courses will be taught by Dr. Don Powell (Department of Management, UNT). Classes, housing and breakfasts are provided.

The program is open to all UNT students!

Enrollment is limited to eighteen students.

Application Process And Cost Estimates

First, submit your application and \$150 deposit to the Study Abroad Center, Kendall Hall 115 (565-2207) **as soon as possible**. Next, complete an application for a \$600 scholarship.

Scholarships available:

\$600 IEFS Scholarship
\$100 COBA (First 15 applicants to this program)

Payment Deadlines:

Feb 24, 2006: AIFS (1/2 of balance)
March 31, 2006: Balance of fees to AIFS

Student is responsible for applicable UNT tuition, books and passport.
