	Transcripts of course work (copies are sufficient, since official copies sent to Graduate School).
	Resume or vita that includes the candidate's previous work or educational experiences.

	A personal statement from the candidate stating his or her goals and rationale for applying to the Educational Research program. Include a brief statement describing career and research expectations with regard to work and further education. Candidates should also describe their relevant educational experiences and strengths that relate to seeking a doctoral degree in Educational Research.
