A student interested in applying for the doctoral degree in Educational Research is required to fulfill and submit the following:

- Admission to UNT Toulouse Graduate School.
- Master's degree from an accredited college or university or 30 hours of graduate credit from an accredited institution. This degree does not have to be in education.
- A grade point average (GPA) of 3.4 or higher overall on a 4.0 point system.
- GRE scores on the verbal and quantitative sections: Verbal: _____ Quantitative: _____
- Three letters of recommendation from individuals knowledgeable of the candidates capabilities, particularly as it regards research capacity.
- Transcripts of course work (copies are sufficient, since official copies sent to Graduate School).
- Resume or vita that includes the candidate's previous work or educational experiences.
- Sample of scholarly writing skills.
- A personal statement from the candidate stating his or her goals and rationale for applying to the Educational Research program. Include a brief statement describing career and research expectations with regard to work and further education. Candidates should also describe their relevant educational experiences and strengths that relate to seeking a doctoral degree in Educational Research.
- A written critical response (maximum 2 pages, double spaced) to an article. This article is listed on the EDER website (<http://www.coe.unt.edu/eder>).

Fall Admissions requires all materials to be completed and processed by April 1st.

Spring Admissions requires all materials to be completed and processed by November 1st.
