**Re:** FY 2004 Sponsored Projects Activity Report

Attached is the FY 2004 report of sponsored projects activity. This report presents details of proposals and awards by investigator, department, and school or college. Awards are analyzed by source, amount, and category.

The sponsored projects activity experienced an average annual funding increase of 12.8% over the last five years. In FY04, there were 286 extramural awards totaling \$24,744,514.

Compared to FY03, the average total award increased by 11.7% to \$86,519. The average indirect cost recovery was 11.1%.

State and private awards decreased approximately 14.7% and 11.4% respectively, while direct federal awards increased 18.3%. Additionally, the number of FY04 proposals submitted decreased 15% to 479 and the amount requested increased 7% to \$145,168,398.

# Charts: Category Totals by Source, FY 2004



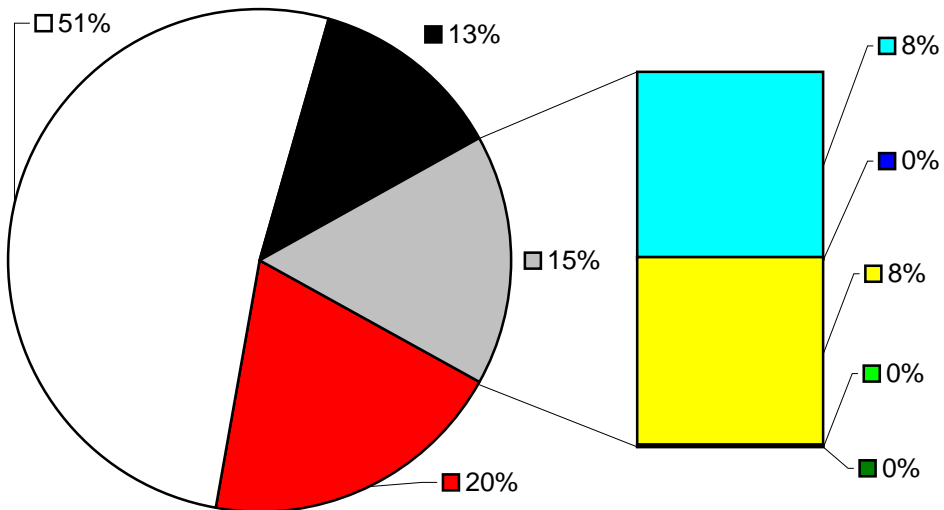

# Charts: Award Totals by Source, FY 2004



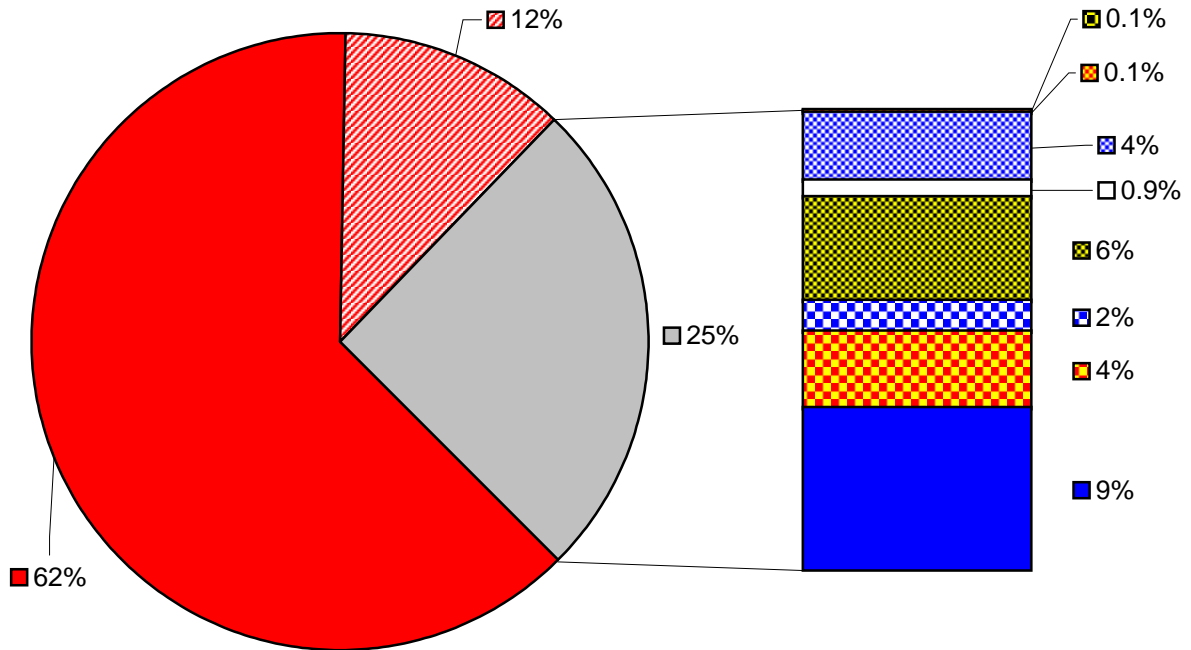
