- A. Five categories will be evaluated on a rating scale of 1-6 points, with 6 being the highest, and 30 points being the highest possible amount of points received overall. Judging will be based on the following categories:
 - 1. Originality/Creativity
 - 2. Observance of theme
 - 3. Mean Green Eagle Spirit (enthusiasm and spirit)
 - 4. Craftsmanship (safety, materials used, sturdiness, etc.)
 - 5. Attractiveness (colors, shapes, neatness, etc.)
- B. A panel of judges will consist of representatives from multiple areas of the university community such as faculty/staff, students, alumnae, and community leaders. **Judging for Greek floats begins at 2:00 Friday.** All other judging will take place on Saturday, October 16th @ 11:30 AM.
- C. BANNERS & TROPHIES will be given before the parade so the winning floats can display them along the parade route.
- D. CASH AWARDS May be picked up from the Student Activities Center, Union 320. **DEADLINE IS Nov. 1st to collect the prize money or the money will be forfeited.**
- E. The trophy classifications are:
 - 1. <u>President's Trophy</u>: Best "overall" float. (\$500 cash prize)
 - **2. Greek Eagle Spirit Trophy:** Most outstanding entry from Greek campus organizations. (\$400 cash prize) (Second place Greek winner if a Greek team wins the President's Trophy)
 - 3. Honorable Mention: Greek Eagle Spirit: (\$300 cash prize)
 - **4.** <u>Independent Eagle Spirit Trophy</u>: Most outstanding entry from Independent campus organizations. (\$300 cash prize)
 - **5.** <u>Scrappy Award:</u> Best float decoration 50% and 50% "Yell Like Hell" participation (\$400 cash prize)
 - 6. Honorable Mention: Scrappy Award: (\$200 cash prize)
 - **7.** Eagle Claw Award: 50% "spirit wall" decoration and 50% "Yell Like Hell" participation. (\$400 cash prize).
 - **8. <u>UNT Departmental Spirit Trophy</u>**: Most outstanding entry from a department in the University. (\$300 cash prize)
 - **9. N.T. Friendship Trophy:** Most outstanding entry from non-university organizations.
 - **10.** McAdow Marching Unit Trophy: Best non band marching entry.
 - 11. Corporate Trophy: Most outstanding entry from area business.

The Homecoming Spirit Walls are an approximately 4' x 8' sheet of plywood with a frame that allows for the wall to be stood up.

While the Spirit Wall is provided, each organization will need to provide their own paint or supplies to decorate their wall. Since the Spirit Walls will be displayed outdoors through Homecoming Week, it is recommended that decorations be able to withstand the possibility of bad weather.

Because there are a limited number of Spirit Walls, registration for campus departments and student organizations will be processed on a first come, first served basis. Confirmation will be emailed to the department/organization contact.

Participants should pick up their wall at the RHA House (1510 West Maple) on Wednesday, October 6th from 1 PM to 4 PM. Because the Spirit Walls are large and fairly heavy, it is a good idea to arrange for a truck to transport the wall

Completed Spirit Walls MUST be in the Willis Library Mall by Tuesday, October 12th **by 9:30 AM.** Judging of the Spirit Walls will occur at the Homecoming Kick-Off Picnic on Tuesday and the winners will be announced at the event. Participating departments and organizations are encouraged to have representation at their wall during the picnic to show their school spirit.

Spirit Walls need to be removed from the Library Mall and returned to the RHA House by Monday, October 20th at noon.

Method of Payment:

University of North Texas Homecoming 2010 Mean Green Village Information

The planned activities begin 3 hours prior to kickoff and ends 30 minutes prior to kickoff on Saturday, October 16. It is held in Traditions Field, next to Fouts Field. Kickoff is currently scheduled for 6:30pm.

- 1. **Space Reservation & Assignment:** Staff will assign all tent spaces. Participants cannot trade spots nor can they move to another spot without approval from Staff.
- Event Map: The Mean Green Village map will not be available until late Thursday or early Friday
 of Homecoming week. It will be posted on the website at www.unt.edu/homecoming. PLEASE
 DO NOT call to request a map.
- 3. **Event Hours:** The planned activities begin 3 hours prior to kickoff and closes 30 minutes prior to kickoff. Please plan to have your space open for the duration of the event.
- 4. **Set Up:** You may begin set up as early as 8:00am Saturday. Flat bed golf carts will be available at the back gate on Santa Fe. All vehicles will be required to have an Orange Lot Parking Pass in order to enter and unload. Passes will be mailed the first week of October. Any unauthorized vehicles on Santa Fe will be towed.
- 5. <u>Catered Food:</u> If you are having food catered, you must purchase an Orange Lot Parking Pass for the vendor and provide it to them in advance in order for them to deliver your order.
- 6. <u>Food/Beverages:</u> Food items should be intended to be shared with invited guests and not provided as a giveaway to all comers. The same applies to beverages.
- 7. **Equipment:** By reserving equipment, including tents, tables & chairs, you are agreeing to utilize all items in the correct manner. Alteration or destruction of university property is prohibited.
- 8. <u>Tent Sign:</u> Do not remove the tent sign; leave it at your assigned space following the event. If your sign does not remain in your space, your group will be charged an additional \$25.00.
- 9. <u>Tear Down:</u> Mean Green Village will close 30 minutes prior to kickoff. All participants are expected to tear down your space at this time; power will remain on for a limited time to assist with tear down.
- 10. <u>Electricity:</u> Participants who reserve electricity at their space must indicate what items are to be powered on the Tent Reservation Form in order to ensure enough electricity. Please plan to provide your own power cords. Power will be turned off in the Village immediately prior to kickoff.
- 11. <u>Solicitation:</u> Businesses participating with the intent to network and solicit business must indicate such on the Tent Reservation Form for appropriate processing and handling. Participants are prohibited from soliciting outside of their assigned space. Literature is prohibited from being placed anywhere on the grounds, including but not limited to car windshields, bathrooms, picnic areas, etc.
- 12. <u>Trash:</u> Each group is responsible for keeping their assigned space clean, neat and orderly at all times. This includes hauling away any trash or garbage that is generated in or around the space.

13. Refunds/Cancellations:

- a. No refunds will be given due to the group being removed from the premises for any reason.
- b. Participants may cancel this reservation by mailing or emailing a written request. This request must be received no later than 5:00pm October 6, 2010.
- c. No refunds will be issued due to inclement weather.

These rules have been established to satisfy the diverse needs of our participants. Staff reserve the right to change these regulations at any time.

There will be a MANDATORY meeting in which your Team representatives from each organization must attend. A confirmation letter or e-mail will provide the time and location of the meeting upon receipt of required forms and fees.

For the competition, please keep in mind:

- You must arrive 20 minutes before your performance for check in. If you do not show up to check in, you will not be able to perform.
- A time limit of NO MORE THAN 2 MINUTES will be strictly enforced. If you go over the
 time limit, you will be disqualified. Remember, this is a spirit competition. You may
 dance and step, but make sure your performance ties into the Homecoming theme which
 is: "Old School"
- Judging will be based on these categories: Spirit, Creativity, Organization, Time Limit (1-2 minutes), Old School theme incorporation into show, and clarity
- You are required to give PBSO at least 48 hours notice if your organization is not able to participate because adjustments will have to be made to the show.
