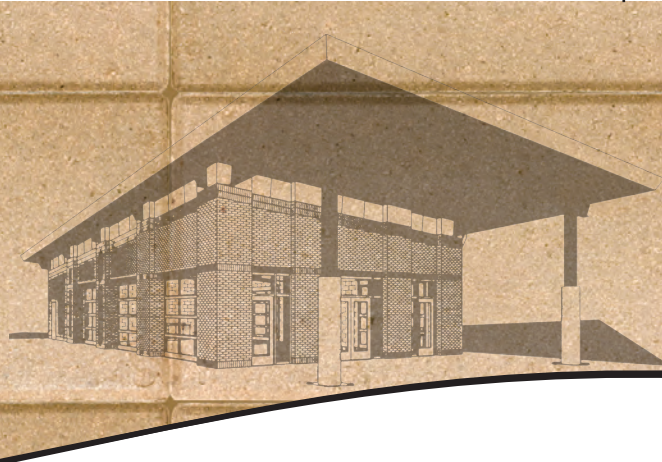

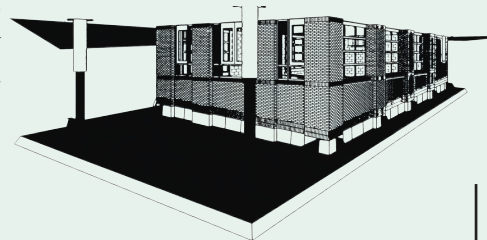

ALUMNI PAVILION FEATURES

Location: Near the northeast (main) entrance to the new stadium

Square footage: more than 5,000 total square foot imprint

Includes a 2,000 square foot indoor pavilion and a 3,200 square foot exterior patio, located on the south side of the pavilion, with additional green space to accommodate tables and chairs

Capacity: 150 inside the pavilion

Architectural Design: HKS, the architectural firm that designed the stadium also designed the pavilion. It will be constructed of the same brick and will follow the LEED certification of the stadium.

Features:

- Enclosed and heated in the winter
- Ceiling fans for hot days
- Big screen TV's
- Restrooms
- Food and beverage service area

Additional Benefit: The UNT Alumni Pavilion will be available to rent for special events.
