Fees & Forms	<p>Mandatory: Final approved ETDs have TWO destinations: UNT Libraries and ProQuest (PQ).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Archive</i> = \$20 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ This fee covers all activities associated with getting the ETD to the UNT Libraries, and keeping it available in perpetuity. ▶ Students must submit signed UNT Electronic Filing Form with UNT graduation materials. • <i>Microfilm</i> = \$25 (diss/thesis) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ This fee is what PQ charges UNT for their thesis and dissertation services. ▶ Students must submit signed PQ agreement form with UNT graduation materials. 	<p>Student pays PQ directly for these <u>optional</u> services.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Bound copies</i> • <i>Open Access (OA)</i> = \$95 • <i>Copyright registration</i> = (\$55) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Do NOT have to use PQ - students can do it themselves via www.copyright.gov ▶ Registration may be made at any time within the life of the copyright, but there are specific time frames for certain benefits – check FAQs on fed Web site.

Section II-B. Rights pursuant to Open Access Publishing.

Author's election of Open Access as the Type of Publishing confirms Author's choice to have ProQuest/UMI publish the Work according to the Open Access Publishing option described here.

Open Access Publishing. In addition to the rights granted under Section I of this UMI® Publishing Agreement, ProQuest/UMI may reproduce, distribute, display and transmit the Work in electronic format in the ProQuest Dissertations and Theses Open database (PQDT Open) or successor database(s), where it will be made available for free download. PQDT Open may be accessed by the academic community as well as through major search engines and

open access harvesters. ProQuest/UMI may also provide an electronic copy of the Work to Author's degree-granting institution where it may also be posted for free open access.

Copy Sales. ProQuest/UMI and its agents and distributors may offer copies of the Work for sale in tangible media, including but not limited to microform, print and CD-ROM, as well as in electronic format either individually or as part of its electronic database and reference products and services. No royalties shall be due to Author.

Publishing Fees. Author's payment of the additional Open Access fee is a one-time, up-front fee in addition to the UMI® dissertation or thesis publishing fee. Author's institution may assess additional fees to be collected along with the Open Access and publishing fees.

Traditional Publishing

 - I understand that the ProQuest/UMI fee for Traditional Publishing is \$55 for Master's thesis and \$65 for Doctoral dissertations.

Open Access Publishing

 - I understand that the ProQuest/UMI fee for Open Access Publishing of Master's thesis is \$150 and for Dissertations is \$160, and that my graduate institution may pay all or a portion of the total fee as well as may require additional fees in association with my submission to ProQuest/UMI.
