Patrol vehicles are fully equipped with touch screen computers, mobile report writing software, digital mobile video, RADAR and more. Officers have access to the most modern technology to include thermal imagers, hand held LIDAR units, and mobile surveillance systems.

Continuous Training

New officers will be required to attend a police academy if unlicensed, and complete a demanding field training program. Officers will continue to receive bimonthly inservice training and have the opportunity to attend advanced training courses which will further develop the officer's skills.

- ▶ Must be a U.S Citizen
- ▶ Must be 21 years of age
- ▶ Must have a valid Texas drivers license
- ▶ No conviction for any felony
- ▶ No conviction for Class A or B misdemeanors

All candidates for sworn police officer positions must be able to comply with TCLEOSE requirements for licensure
