Automatic Admission

Applicants who graduated in the top 10 percent of their high school class shall be admitted automatically to the University.

Regular Admission

Applicants shall be guaranteed admission if they:

- Rank in the next 15 percent or
- Rank in the 2nd quarter and have a minimum 1010 SAT I or 21 ACT or
- Rank in the 3rd quarter and have a minimum 1100 SAT I or 24 ACT or
- Rank in the 4th quarter and have a minimum 1180 SAT I or 27 ACT.

Note: All applicants to the University of North Texas must submit SAT I or ACT scores. High school seniors who plan to attend UNT should take entrance examinations at least five months before enrollment dates.
