- 42 hours must be advanced;

- Stringed Instruments (Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass):**
1. Eight semesters of MULB 1805, Symphony Orchestra.
  2. A minimum of 2 hours in a secondary stringed instrument.
  3. Preparation of two programs of representative works from classic, romantic and contemporary styles. The equivalent of one-half recital must be given the junior year and a full recital in the senior year.
