Application Procedures

The application for admission to the School of Graduate Studies at the University of North Texas should be submitted, with official credentials, at least two months prior to the semester of enrollment. Please refer to the calendar in this catalog for application deadline dates appropriate to each semester and for certain degree programs.

For degree and nondegree candidates, credentials include:

- Complete official transcripts from all previous colleges and universities
- Official Graduate Management Admissions Test (College of Business) or Graduate Record Examination (all other UNT programs) scores from Educational Testing Service for degree-seeking students
- Completed application form
- Application fee

In addition, individual departments may require additional credentials such as letter of recommendation, statement of professional goals, etc. Contact your major department to determine if additional materials are needed.

All students are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

If applications and credentials are received after the deadline, the student will be subject to late registration and the late registration fee. Late applicants should expect delays in the processing of their materials.

Only written notice from the dean of the School of Graduate Studies constitutes approval of admission, not correspondence with department chairs or with individual faculty members.
