## Application for Admission

The University of North Texas accepts the State of Texas “Common Application for Freshman Admission” and the “Common Application for Transfer/Transient/Readmit.” All new and former undergraduate applicants may use these forms.

### Admission Deadlines

<b>Fall semester 1999</b>	June 15, 1999
<b>Spring semester 2000</b>	December 1, 1999
<b>Mini-mester 2000</b>	May 11, 2000
<b>First summer term 2000</b>	May 15, 2000
<b>Second summer term 2000</b>	June 30, 2000

### Automatic Admission

Applicants who graduated in the top 10 percent of their high school class shall be admitted automatically to the University.

### Regular Admission

Applicants shall be guaranteed admission if they:

- Rank in the next 15 percent or
- Rank in the 2nd quarter and have a minimum 1010 SAT I or 21 ACT or
- Rank in the 3rd quarter and have a minimum 1100 SAT I or 24 ACT or
- Rank in the 4th quarter and have a minimum 1180 SAT I or 27 ACT.

**Note:** All applicants to the University of North Texas must submit SAT I or ACT scores.

High school seniors who plan to attend UNT should take entrance examinations at least five months before enrollment dates. See high school counselor for more information or write: College Board ATP, P.O. Box 592, Princeton, NJ 08540; or ACT, P.O. Box 168, Iowa City, IA 52243-0168.
