1. In the left side of the webpage, under "My Accommodations", select "List Accommodations".




Figure 1: Image of AIM Service/Accommodation offerings in Student Profile

2. From "Select Accommodations for Your Classes", review the Important Note, and proceed to "Step 1: Select Class(es)"




Figure 2: Image of "select accommodations for your class" followed by a list of the student's classes.
