** Does not require labs for all science courses, though some labs are required to enroll in other prerequisite coursework, it would also be beneficial to take the labs to be competitive for other PT schools.

Does not require Biology I and II Does not require GRE

Any PSYC elective (3hrs) Only requires 3hrs of Biology *Recommended but NOT required: BIOL 3500, MATH 1680, KINE 3050, and KINE 3080 Does not require GRE
