04.014 Reasonable Accommodations & Auxiliary Aids for People with Disabilities	Administration

Policy Statement. In accordance with Section 503 and 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the University of North Texas will make reasonable adjustments in its policies and practices to ensure equal opportunity and access for qualified students, employees, and members of the public to applicable programs, services, activities and facilities.

Application of Policy. Total University.

Procedures and Responsibilities.

In accordance with Section 503 and 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the University of North Texas will make reasonable adjustments in its policies and practices to ensure equal opportunity and access for qualified students, employees, and members of the public to applicable programs, services, activities and facilities.

Requests for special accommodation or auxiliary aids should be made well in advance of need to the responsible university department or agency. Proof of disability may be required if the disability is not evident. The department or agency responsible for the program, activity, service or facility to which the individual requires access will work with the appropriate university vice president and/or federal or state agency to ensure that reasonable accommodations are made.

The University assumes no responsibility for personal assistance necessary for independent functioning nor for specialized medical care.
