

- 06.300 Faculty Appointments
- 06.301 Faculty Appointments. Each Institution shall appoint faculty necessary to accomplish the mission and goals of the Institution.
- 06.302 Faculty Reappointments. Each Institution shall comply with Texas Education Code § 51.943 regarding faculty reappointment.
- 06.303 Emeritus Appointments. The Board may confer the designation of “Emeritus Professor” to faculty members after their retirement from full-time faculty employment. The retired faculty member must meet the eligibility requirements set by the Institution and be recommended to the Board following the Institution’s selection procedures.
- 06.304 Regents’ Professors. The Board may award the designation of “Regents’ Professor” to provide recognition and salary support to a tenured full professor who has performed outstanding teaching, research, and service to the profession and who has achieved a high level of national and international recognition. To be considered, a candidate must meet the eligibility requirements set by the Institution and be recommended to the Board following the Institution’s selection procedures. The Institution shall review Regents’ Professors as required by Institution policy to determine continued eligibility for the position.
- 06.305 Named Professorships and Chairs. The holder of a named professorship or chair should be an outstanding scholar, artist, business authority, or performer submitted to the Board through the Institution’s established recommendation process. The naming shall comply with Regents Rule 09.203.8 and other applicable requirements related to naming as set forth in Regents Rules 09.200.
