**Degree Requirements and Information**

- **Minimum Grades:** Grade of C or above in all required courses.
- **UNT GPA:** Minimum 2.000 GPA on all course work at UNT.
- **GPA (All Courses):** Minimum 2.000 GPA, UNT and transfer hours included (minimum 2.750 GPA for *Admission to Teacher Education*).
- **University Core GPA:** Minimum 2.750 GPA required in completed University Core.
- **Academic Major GPA:** Minimum 2.750 GPA required in completed Academic Major.
- **Total Hours:** Minimum of 123 total hours, at least 31 hours earned in residence at UNT. Completion of minimum hours required for the degree does not guarantee completion of all degree requirements.
- **Best Choices:** Specific courses **recommended** in some Core categories. Students may elect to take a different course listed under the University Core Curriculum to fulfill these requirements.

4) Once the offer letter is accepted and on record in the COE-SAO, enrollment in TEd courses is permitted during a valid enrollment period.
