Research, Funding News



During this outage, there will be no access to these websites, proposals cannot be submitted in FastLane or Research.gov. Considering this and the volume expected for the NSF Core program submissions, OGCA will start reviewing proposals due Nov 14th between Nov 6th - Nov 8th.

Our Faculty are invited to register for one of two grant proposal planning and writing workshops on Monday, Dec 9th, 2019 and Thursday, Feb 27th, 2020. The Office of Research and Innovation is partnering with the distinguished AtKisson Training Group LLC, to deliver a one-day grant writing workshop focused on proposal preparation and review processes that lead to increased external funding submission success.

FY20 Appropriations Bills: NASA In their fiscal year 2020 spending legislation, the House and Senate are both proposing stable funding for NASA's Science Mission Directorate, though the funding level Senate appropriators have proposed for the Wide Field Infrared Survey Telescope could result in a delayed launch.

FY20 Appropriations Bills: STEM Education The House and Senate have advanced spending bills that would provide steady or increased funding to most major STEM education programs across the federal government.
