___ **Three (3) recommendations**

Recommendations must be signed and dated on letterhead. Alternatively, recommendation forms may be downloaded from UNT's web site or picked up in BLB 201. All recommendations should be professional or academic in nature. They must be written by college professors and / or supervisors and managers, only. Recommendations are not acceptable from family, friends, clergy, high school teachers / administrators, subordinates, co-workers, etc.
