### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students applying to the MS in Accounting with a focus on Corporate Accounting must have successfully completed all accounting backgrounds courses before applying to the program. A student must have a minimum accounting GPA of 3.0 in order to be considered for the MS in Accounting with a concentration in Corporate Accounting.

The Ryan College of Business Graduate Programs Office works with students to determine if background deficiency courses will be necessary.
