The bachelor's degree is for persons wishing to pursue the professions of speech-language pathology or audiology. The program provides basic preparation in the normal development and functioning of speech, language, and hearing, and introductory courses concerned with communication disorders and appropriate remedial procedures. Clinical activities are scheduled concurrently with academic courses.

Implementation Plan of 3-Year Degree:

-Students will be required to transfer in 30 hours of UNT Core equivalent courses.

-The B.S. degree in Audiology in Speech-Language Pathology requires specific math and science courses, specifically MATH 1680, BIOL 1112, PHYS 1270 or PHYS 1350 and CHEM 1310 or BIOL 2301&2311 which can be used for University Core requirements. If the student transfers in other math or science classes, these hours will be accepted as part of the 30 hour requirement, but the student will be required to take the missing ASLP math or science required classes later on and counted as an elective.

-Because of the content of the Upper Level ASLP courses, only 12 hours are recommended in their senior year. Because of this, students will need to take two ASLP courses in the summer between their junior and senior year. The two courses (ASLP 3025 and ASLP 4050) are not currently taught in the summer, thus additional financial resources will be required to provide these courses.
