- Must currently have and maintain a 2.75 cumulative UNT GPA or higher
- Must be able to meet with advisor and board monthly during fall/spring semesters
- Demonstrate strong written and verbal communication skills
- Demonstrate strong networking and customer service skills

- Serve at UNT Alumni Association and Advancement events
- Accurately represent the organization's mission and effectively market to prospective members
- Engage with alumni and graduating seniors to promote joining the Alumni Association

- Join the Alumni Association at the student member rate
