"10 Things to Remember"

1. If your child has allergies or food restrictions, be sure to inform us.
2. Please check with the office and make sure your phone numbers are current.
3. Sign your child **in** and **out** every day.
4. Touch base with your child's Head Teacher to make sure the teacher knows that your child has arrived each day.
4. Pin your child's name tag on after you sign him/her in.
5. Children are dismissed to parents **ONLY**, unless you have informed us in advance.
6. Prompt pick-up is important, including when we call to let you know your child is sick.
7. Children must leave all toys at home (this includes jewelry and chap sticks, lotions, etc. - anything children might share and pick up germs from.)
8. Let teachers know if you would like to participate in any way.
9. Please hold your child's hand when exiting the building.
10. Your thoughts and opinions are very important. Please share them with us.
