

## *Eligibility for the Society of Physics Students (SPS) Scholarship*

This scholarship is a fund for the support of undergraduate students enrolled in a Physics degree program within the College Science at UNT.

This scholarship is awarded for one academic year (beginning in the fall semester) in amounts up to \$1000 per year. The stipend is awarded via a student fee payment at the beginning of each semester, reducing the recipient's tuition bill by that amount each semester.

**To be considered for the SPS Scholarship, an applicant must meet the following requirements:**

1. Minimum entrance and academic performance standards of the College of Science in effect at the time of any award.
2. Maintain full-time enrollment, majoring within an undergraduate Physics academic program at UNT, unless the applicant has less than twice the number of semester hours required to be full-time remaining in his/her degree program.
3. Submit the following:
  - **The completed scholarship application form,**
  - **Two reference reports, and**
  - **All college work transcripts.**

### **Application Deadline:**

The completed application form, reference reports, and transcripts must be submitted by **5:00 PM CDT on March 15** to be considered for the following Fall semester.
