| TOP 10% | no minimum score* | no minimum score* |
| NEXT 15% | 1030 | 20 |
| SECOND QTR. | 1130 | 23 |
| THIRD QTR. | 1250 | 26 |

* Although no minimum scores are required, you must still submit your scores.
