SECTION IV: DAVID J. EWING SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

DEADLINE: Completed applications with required supplemental documentation must be received by UNT Student Financial Aid & Scholarships by 5:00 p.m., March 1, 2019 in order to be considered.

1. Applicants must attend an accredited institution of higher education.
2. Applicants must meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of the higher education institution he/she is attending.
3. Applicants must be classified as an undergraduate student in one of the degree programs offered by the institution (freshman and sophomore students may enroll as “undecided majors”).
4. Applicants must maintain full-time enrollment unless the student is nearing completion of his/her degree and has less than 24 semester hours remaining in his/her degree plan.

Note: Scholarship recipients must complete an appeal for less than full-time enrollment

5. Applicants must submit the following with their completed application:
 - a) official high school or college transcripts (including all transfer hours),
 - b) two letters of professional recommendation from teachers or employers who are non-family members,
 - c) an essay discussing your professional goals and need for a scholarship (two-page maximum, typed, double-spaced),
 - d) a copy of the death certificate and/or obituary, and
 - e) a copy of your 2019-2020 FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR), www.fafsa.gov, showing your official EFC and responses to dependency questions. The 2019-2020 FAFSA is available October 1, 2018.
