University Requirements for Degree

- UNT GPA: Minimum 2.000 GPA on all course work at UNT.
- Overall GPA: Minimum 2.000 GPA on all course work attempted, transfer hours included.
- Advanced Hours: 42 advanced hours (3000/4000 level courses); at least 24 advanced hours in residence.
- Total Hours: 120 or 123 hours, based on track selected; at least 30 hours in residence. Completion of total hours does not guarantee completion of all requirements.

- Best Selection Courses: University Core courses recommended for successful completion of degree requirements and state certification

- Elective Hours: There are no elective hours for EC-6 Generalist with a specialization track. EC-6 Generalist requires 3 elective hours.

- Junior standing (60 credit hours earned);
- □ A 2.75 overall GPA (includes all transferred and UNT courses) **OR** a 2.75 GPA in the core with all graded courses complete;
- ☐ Minimum THEA scores of 240 reading, 230 math, and 220 writing **OR** exemptions based on SAT, ACT, TSI Assessment or TAKS/TAAS/STAAR scores;
- ☐ A Final Result of *Interview Approved* for the online admission Interview Questionnaire;
- □ Active enrollment at UNT and a completed or in-process degree audit in the College of Education Student Advising Office.
