



## CFA RECOGNIZED UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

## **June and December Exams**

Each year, the FIREL faculty can sponsor multiple students for the Chartered Financial Analyst exam offered in June and December. The CFA program provides an important certification for those working or intending to work in the investments profession. The scholarship will waive the CFA Program enrollment fee and reduce the exam registration fee (includes access to the curriculum eBook) to US\$350. This is a potential value of \$1,000 or more.

The scholarship candidate must be a currently enrolled student in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at UNT. Once a scholarship candidate has received the Awareness Scholarship from CFA Institute, graduation or other separation from enrollment with the sponsor institution will not void the scholarship.

- 2. You must also email a current resume, unofficial transcript(s) and a copy of the CFA® Program University Student Scholarship Application form with applicant section completed to firel@unt.edu

## **APPLICATION DEADLINES\*:**

September 1 -- FOR DECEMBER EXAM ADMINISTRATION February 1 -- FOR JUNE EXAM ADMINISTRATION

\*If deadline falls on a weekend, deadline is first business date following.

Payment will not be required until after the student has been notified that a scholarship was awarded.
