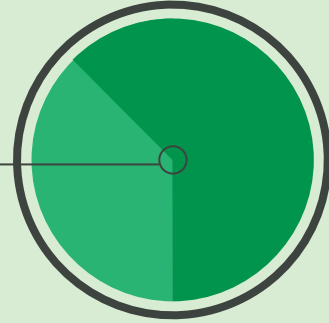
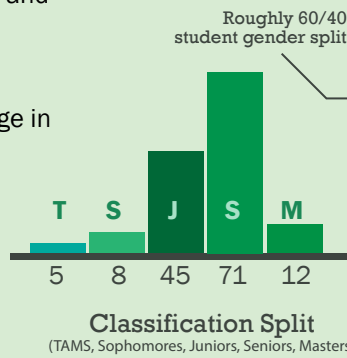

The program is home to students across every level of university classification, from TAMS students to graduate students.

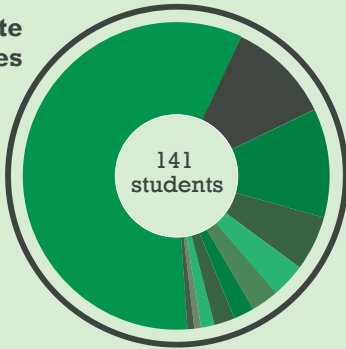

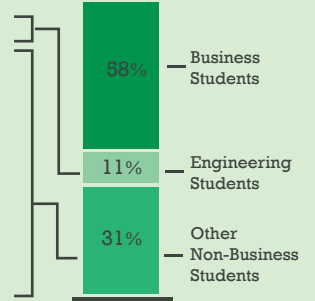

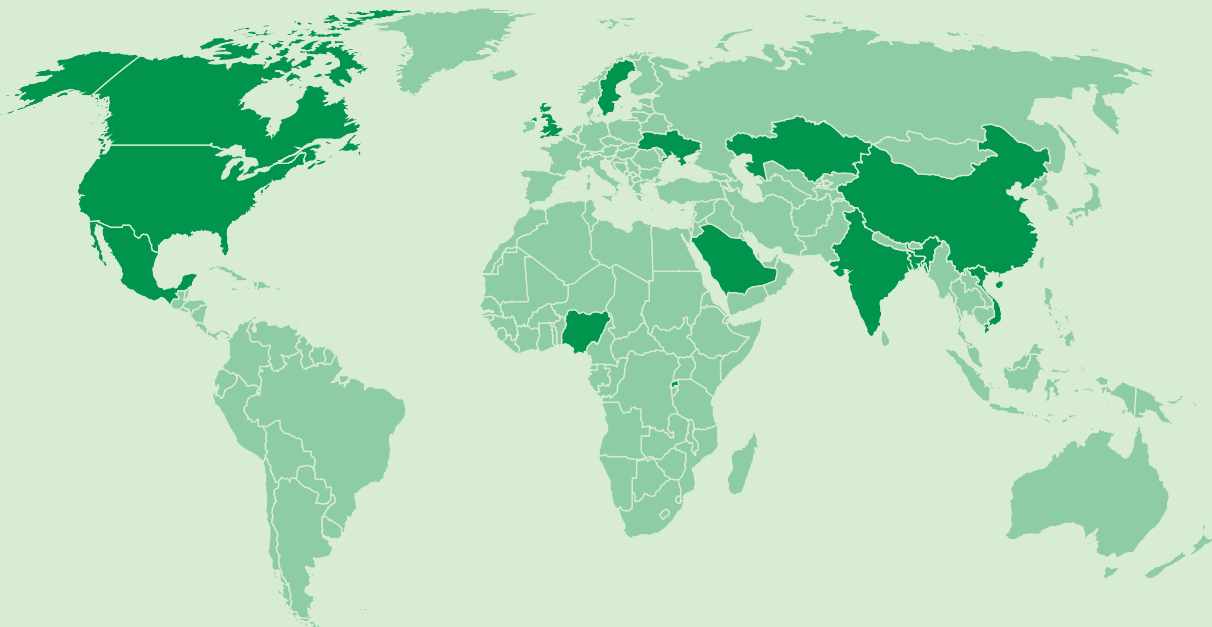
