The Bachelor of Arts with a major in Social Science is an interdisciplinary major in which a student can choose courses from 9 social science departments across the university: Anthropology, Economics, Human Geography, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Social Work.

In this major, you will complete at least 18 semester hours in a primary study area and an additional 30 semester hours in two or more complementary subject areas. Out of these 48 semester hours in the major, at least 24 semester hours must be taken at the advanced level.

You could be on the fast track to success with the insights you gain while studying within the Social Science program. You will have a greater understanding of societal needs, diverse cultures and individual responsibility. Your viewpoints could prove vital to how a company or organization operates.
