The Bachelor of Arts with a major in English, concentration in English Language Arts, prepares you to be certified to teach grades 7-12 in Texas public schools. 7-12 ELA students must maintain a 2.75 GPA and must apply for admission to the College of Education upon completion of 60 hours.

The final semester of your degree requires that you complete student teaching, a 6-credit commitment that is the equivalent of a full-time job. Plan accordingly to decrease your other commitments during that final semester.
