## Helping you attract the public to your event: Site Locator Services

The Site Locator Line connects interested members of the community with your organization. New for this year, the Site Locator will include details about your event (including dates and times) and will broadcast those event details to callers. If you plan to open your site to the public, don't miss this opportunity to alert your community members about the date, time, and location of your screening event!

Available on the NASD Web site and through a toll-free phone number, the Site Locator lists all sites across the country that are open to the public. The goal is to reach out to as many individuals as possible and increase attendance at NASD events.

#### The Site Locator Line will...

- Advertise your event and increase the number of people that attend. Every year, national media such as Annie's Mailbox (formerly Ann Landers) and PARADE Magazine print articles publicizing the Site Locator Line toll-free number and Web site.
- Inform members of the community about details of your event and/or provide a phone number for the public to call and learn more about your screening.

To be included on the Site Locator Line, fill out the details of your event on the registration form on page 3. If you are not sure of the exact details, simply mark your interest and call the NASD office at **1-800-253-7658** with an update.

## SELECT A KIT TAILORED TO YOUR AUDIENCE

*NASD now offers you the opportunity to choose the type of kit(s) that will best suit your needs.* Three English language kits and a supplemental Spanish language kit are available. You can also choose how many screening forms you will need for your event. Your choices are as follows:

**Community Kit:** If you plan to screen members of the general public and need a variety of general educational materials, the community kit will best suit your needs. It is intended for use at a community-based outreach event such as in a shopping center, lobby or cafeteria, community center, or at a health fair.

**College Kit:** Part of the Comprehensive College Initiative (CCI), the college kit is intended for use on college campuses to screen college students, faculty and staff at a campus-wide outreach event. The kit can be used as part of a Greek life or athletic event, or to screen incoming freshmen. Be creative! Note: CCI also offers online screening, allowing your student body to take the screening questionnaire at any time throughout the year. If you are interested in screening your students online, please call 1-800-253-7658.

**Primary/Specialty Care Kit:** Intended for use in a medical or clinical setting, the primary/specialty care materials can be used to screen your patients or clients.

**Supplemental Spanish Language Kit:** The supplemental Spanish Kit includes a variety of materials in Spanish (including screening forms), and should be used to screen Spanish-speaking adults.

## KNOWLEDGE YOU CAN SHARE

- Traffic crashes involving alcohol kill more than 16,000 people each year.
- Research suggests that, in some women, as little as one drink per day can slightly raise the risk of breast cancer.
- 500,000 students between the ages of 18 and 24 are unintentionally injured while under the influence of alcohol.
- Drinking alcohol while taking certain medications can cause problems. In fact, there are more than 150 medications that should not be mixed with alcohol.
- Heavy drinking over a long period of time increases the risk for heart disease, high blood pressure and some kinds of stroke.
- Approximately 14 million Americans meet the diagnostic criteria for alcohol abuse or alcoholism, and more than one-half of American adults have a close family member who has or had alcoholism.
- Drinking alcohol while you are pregnant can cause a range of birth defects, and children exposed to alcohol before birth can have lifelong learning and behavioral problems.
