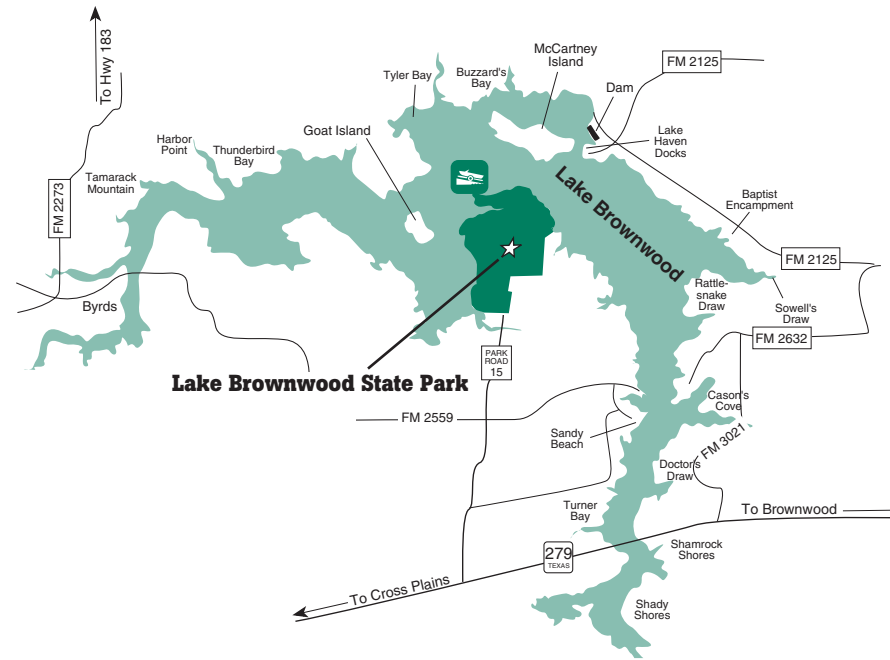
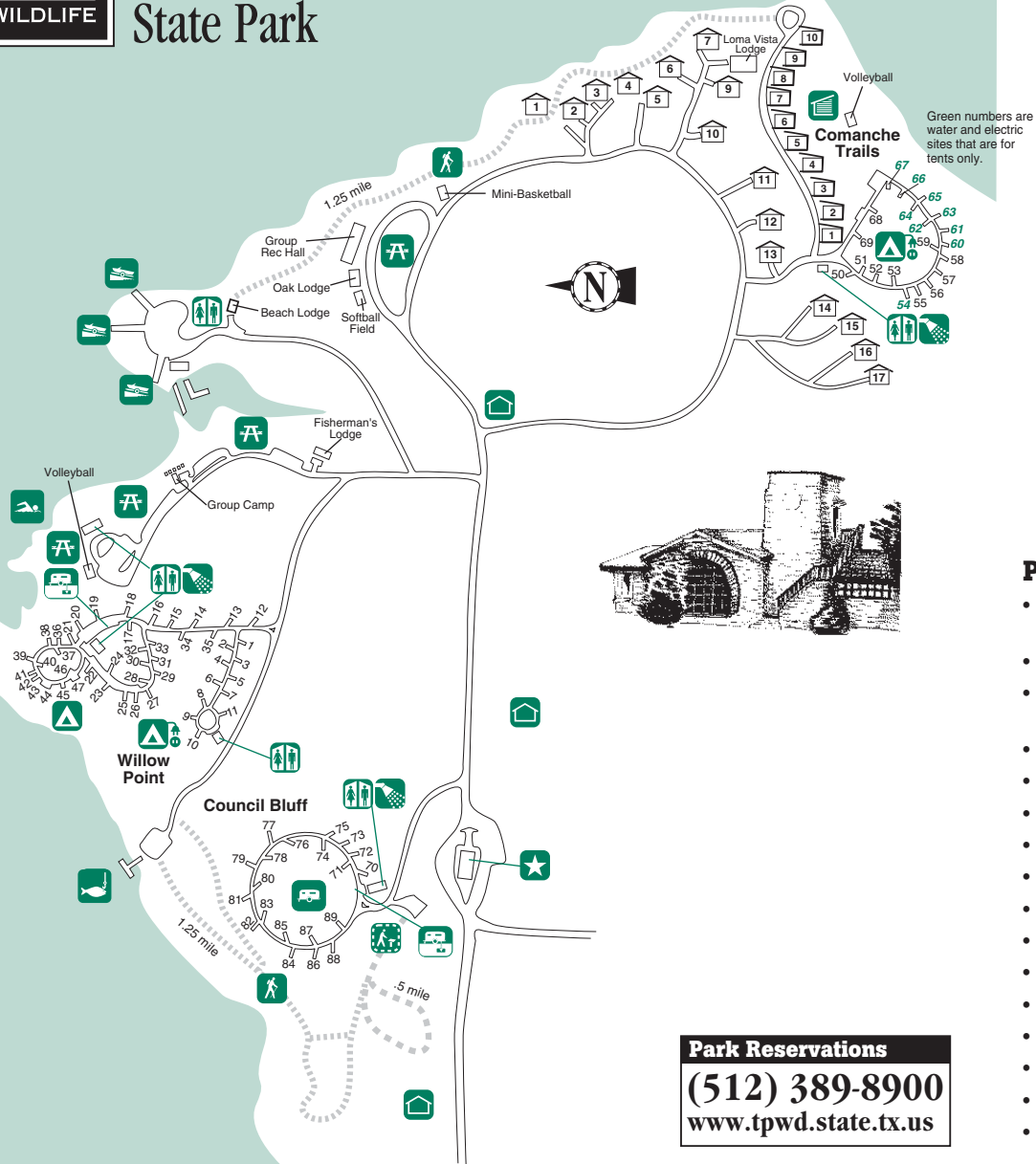


Lake Brownwood State Park



Please Note:

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. for camp sites and shelters or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability). CHECK OUT time is 11 a.m. for cabins, lodges and group facilities.
- Public consumption or display of an open container of alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of eight people per campsite or shelter. Occupancy rate in cabins varies. Guests must leave the park by 10 p.m.
- Quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.; please be considerate of other people.
- No person shall use electrical speakers or radios at a volume which emits beyond the immediate campsite.
- Dogs must be on a leash no longer than six feet and under control at all times.
- Pets are not allowed in any buildings or beach area.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site.
- Swim at your own risk. NO LIFEGUARD on duty.
- Always swim with a friend. Children must be supervised by an adult who can swim.
- Do not block ramp area.
- Launch your vessel and clear the ramp area.
- No glass containers, clean-up or swimming in the ramp area.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities.
