What Happens If I Don't Hear Well?

If I don't have an audiologist, PACT also can help me find one. And, if I need special help in school, call our local school district for a referral to the Regional Day School Program for the Deaf.

PACT Can Help If I Don't Hear Well

PACT helps children from birth to 21 years. The most important time to take care of hearing problems is at the ages on the Hearing Quiz, but PACT helps older kids, too.

If I need it, PACT will pay for:

- **A hearing test by an audiologist**
- **A hearing exam by an ear doctor**
- **An exam to find out if I need a hearing aid**
- **The time you and I need to learn how to use a hearing aid (if I need one)**
- **Follow-up checks of the hearing aid**
- **Fixing or getting a new hearing aid**
- **New earmolds when I need them**
