Subject: 2007 Filing Requirements for Certification as Accredited or Trusteed Reinsurer

The following are the requirements and due dates for filing documentation for 2006 certification of accredited and trusteed reinsurers in Texas. Each reinsurer wanting to maintain their certification or reinsurer requesting certification must submit required documentation.

Attached are the Submission for Reinsurance Accreditation (Form R-1), Certificate of Assuming Reinsurer (Form R-3) and the Accredited Reinsurer Checklist (R-4). The Submission for Reinsurance Accreditation form consisting of two pages and the Certificate of Assuming Reinsurer must be completed, signed and notarized. The Reinsurer Checklist must be completed and returned with all other documents. Please note that some documentation on the Checklist is required to be filed every three years. A Biographical Affidavit must be submitted anytime there is a change in officers or directors, and updated biographical for President, Secretary and Treasurer must be filed if current affidavit was filed prior to 2004.

Forms R-1, R-3 and R-4 (Checklist) must be submitted with the year end 2006 financial statements. **DUE DATE: March 1, 2007**.

Also attached is a copy of a Business Plan Outline to assist in the preparation of the 3-year business plan to be submitted by all new companies seeking registration or updated plans if the current business plan was filed prior to **2004**. **DUE DATE: March 1, 2007**.

The minimum capital and surplus requirement is \$20 million for an accredited/trusteed reinsurer. Failure to maintain at least \$20 million will result in the withdrawal of the accreditated/trusteed status in Texas. Failure to comply with the filing requirements may also subject the insurer to withdrawal of their accreditated/trusteed status.
