Welcome to the new State Highway 121

The first seven miles of the State Highway 121 toll road opened in July 2006, extending from FM 2281 in Carrollton south to the Denton/Dallas county line near Denton Tap Road and DFW Airport. This new roadway offers drivers a muchneeded option to bypass traffic in Denton County and improves access to the airport.

There are no toll booths on this hightech toll road. Drivers either pay with an electronic toll tag or receive a monthly invoice generated by our new video billing system. Either way, there's no stopping or slowing down to pay. Future stretches of State Highway 121 will give drivers relief from traffic congestion in fast-growing areas in Denton and Collin counties.

Expected to open in 2008, the next stretch of the toll road will continue east past State Highway 289. Another section extending the toll road to US 75 is on the drawing board.

State Highway 121 is part of the Texas Department of Transportation's longrange plan to give Texans the first-class transportation system they deserve. This state-of-the-art highway will help reduce traffic congestion, enhance safety, boost the local economy, and improve air quality.





Two ways to pay tolls on State Highway 121

Paying tolls on the new State Highway 121 is simple and easy. There's no stopping or waiting in lines and no searching for change.

Electronic toll tags

TxTag,® TollTag (North Texas Tollway Authority), and EZ TAG (Harris County Toll Road Authority) are all accepted on State Highway 121.

Tolls are deducted automatically from your prepaid toll account when you use the road, provided your license plate and credit card information are up to date.

Use your toll tag where you see these signs and symbols:



At this time,TxTag will not work on international bridges and may not be used to pay for parking at airports or garages.

Pay by mail

No toll tag? No problem. Drivers without a toll tag also are welcome to use State Highway 121. There's no need to prepay or register.

Devices above the toll lanes will record the license plate of any vehicle without a tag, and the registered owner of the vehicle will receive a monthly bill for toll charges.

The toll rates are one-third more for drivers who do not have an electronic toll tag to offset the costs related to processing license plate information. Also, a \$1 fee will be applied to each monthly invoice for non-tag customers.

First of its kind in U.S.

State Highway 121 is the first road in the nation to provide the "pay by mail" or video billing option for paying tolls. While paying by mail costs drivers a little more, it makes it easy and convenient for anyone to use the road, whether or not they have a prepaid toll account.
